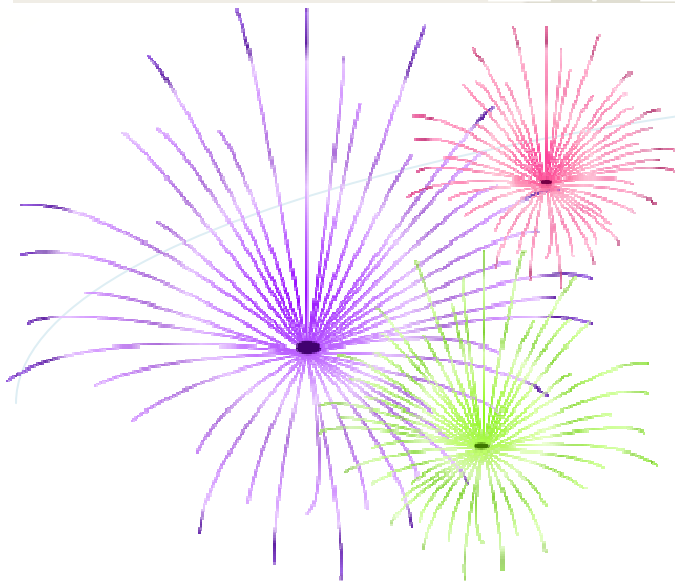

# FREE BOOKS!

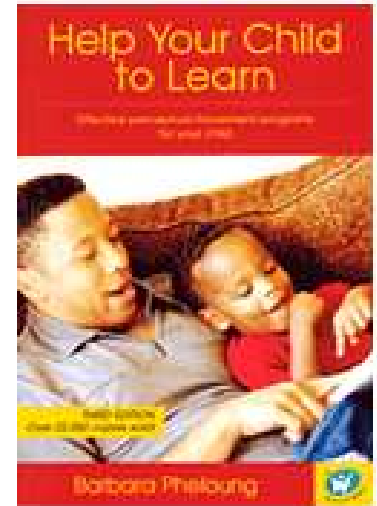
Do you know of any libraries in your area that don't have a copy of the MTL books?

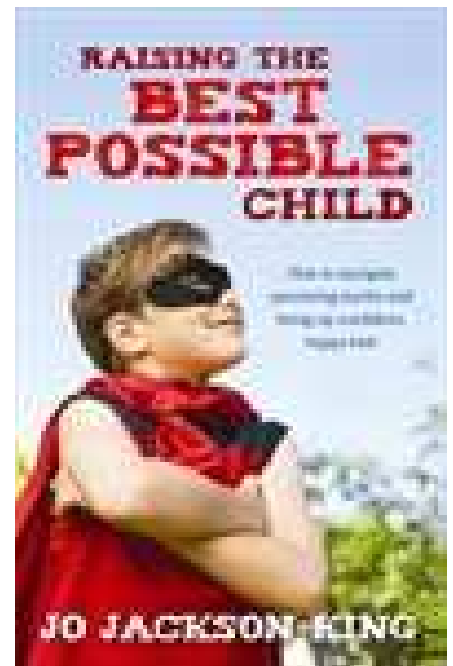
## A Book Recommendation
